

EU / EEA / SWISS FAMILY MEMBER

Please note that your visa application is processed by the **Danish Embassy in London**. The Embassy in Dublin therefore cannot provide status updates or answer questions regarding your specific application.

This checklist applies when you lodge an application under the EU-rules, namely, Directive 2004/38/EC of 29 April 2004 on the right of citizens of the Union and their dependant family members to move and reside freely within the territory of the Member States. **Please see** <u>newtodenmark.dk</u> for guidance on which family members are covered.

If any documents are marked with <u>NO</u> below, your application for a visa for Denmark is *incomplete*. Please arrange with VFS to hand in the missing documents <u>within 5 calendar days from today</u>. If the Embassy has not received the documents by this deadline, the decision will be based on the information available.

You will be informed when a decision on your visa application has been reached or if further information is needed. *Missing documents, declining to provide further documentation or not making yourself available for interview when asked may negatively affect the visa decision.*

Correctly signed application form - Printed and signed ApplyVisa cover letter. Signature must match the one in your passport		
Signed current passport (+ copy of all pages) - If available, previous passport – all previous Schengen visas and stamps must be provided		
Irish residence card (Original IRP card must be shown)		
Proof of EU/EEA/Swiss nationality – copy of family member's EU, EEA or Swiss passport + Original shown		
Proof of family relationship with EU/EEA/Swiss family member – copy of marriage certificate, birth certificate or other reliable proof of family relationship + Original shown		
 Proof of travelling together with or joining the EU/EEA/Swiss family member Choice of any proof e.g. flight/hotel reservation, invitation, letter from family member etc. We recommend that you do <u>not</u> buy any tickets before your visa has been approved 		
Minors (under 18 years) – the following documents must also be provided:		
 Original birth certificate for the minor with both parents' names If one parent has sole custody or guardianship of the minor: Birth certificate mentioning one parent <u>OR</u> Death certificate of absent parent <u>OR</u> Court ruling 		
Original passport of both parents (or ID cards with signature) - If applicable, parents' residence permit proving Irish immigration status		
Written consent for issuance of visa from both parents/guardian(s): Please be aware of the following rules in Ireland: Travelling with children - Immigration Service Delivery
